March 16th , 2021

The meeting was held at the Kendrick Fire Hall at 6:00 pm. The Pledge was said, and meeting was called to order at 6:01 PM.

1) Consent Agenda:

2) Unfinished Business:

A. Wastewater project-

The City sent out a letter as a ditch effort to ask about land for sale. No one responded. The City and Mountain Waterworks has done all they can do to try to acquire any land for the wastewater project. Council member Rose Norris did go look a piece of property that was given to the City by Janice Christianson up Sperry grade next to the Kendrick Cemetery. The land is not large enough for the project. Is the next option possibly pipe the wastewater to the Clearwater? Maybe tying into Juliaetta? There needs to be a meeting with the Stake holders and see what the next best option is for the City of Kendrick with the Wastewater project.

B. 102 Elaine St. – Tabled for now- no new information.

C. Wells Fargo building – Special Use permit for residential.

The Council discussed giving a Special use permit to Janet Jones to use the Commercial Wells Fargo building as a residential building. Council member Carol Bradford made a motion that the Wells Fargo building stay commercial and that they have until June 1st
